Dear SHH Chapter Sponsors:

La Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica de Kentucky (The Kentucky Spanish Honor Society) will be holding its annual convention February 23-24, 2024 at General Butler State Resort Park Carrollton, Kentucky

The convention registration fee is \$50 per student. The convention registration fee covers the special sessions, dinner Friday night, the luncheon Saturday, and the convention t-shirt. We ask that teachers and students stop by the conference rooms at the lodge to pick up their convention packets and t-shirts from 11-12:30 pm on Friday. Teachers will be responsible for checking in students with the lodge and for distributing room keys. Please register using this link.

Click on the link and fill out who is going to attend and how many rooms you will need. This will allow Srta. Del Valle access to see who all is going to attend. Cost for rooms, which will accommodate 4 students, will be \$149.95 per room. This cost includes a hotel tax, which we must pay, but does not include state tax. If you do **not** wish to have Kentucky sales tax added to your cost, you must send a signed tax exempt slip to the park along with the check for the rooms. Make sure to include rooms for all additional chaperones, and bus drivers. The rooming registration form, check, and tax-exempt slip are due to the lodge by **January 17th**. They should be sent to General Butler State Resort Park Carrollton, Kentucky 41008

PLEASE DO NOT PUT YOUR OWN NAME ON THE ROOMING LIST BLOCK ON THE RESERVATION FORM; SRTA. DEL VALLE WILL MAKE RESERVATIONS FOR THE TEACHERS-TWO SCHOOLS PER ROOM FOR TEACHERS. IF YOU WOULD LIKE A PRIVATE ROOM OR TO SHARE WITH ANOTHER CHAPERONE FROM YOUR SCHOOL, YOU MUST PAY MRS. DEL VALLE FOR HALF OF THE ROOM.

The state SHH covers the costs of ONE chaperone per school. The registration form, check for registration fees, and COPY of the reservation form are due to Srta. Del Valle by **JANUARY 17th**.

During the convention, there is a campaign to elect state officers. Each school may run a maximum of three candidates. The convention registration form sent to Srta. Del Valle should contain each candidate's name and information. Candidates should bring the appropriate campaign materials (i.e. posters, name labels, etc.) and be prepared to deliver a 3-5 minute speech in Spanish. Instead of specific offices, students will be running for the convention planning committee that will work together to divide responsibilities throughout the year. Please give a copy of the attached candidate form to all candidates. Candidates must email a short bio, in Spanish, and a recent photo (in jpg format) of themselves to Srta. Del Valle. These will be published in the convention PowerPoint. The deadline for candidate bios and photos is January 30th. Please email those to Srta. Del Valle. Students must be enrolled in Spanish during the 2023-2024 school year in order to serve as state officers.

In addition, seniors will have an opportunity to compete for a Kentucky Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica scholarship. Interested students will participate in a two-part competition on Friday: a written essay from 1:30 to 2:00 at the lodge and an oral section from 6:00-7:00. Topics will be announced on site. We encourage all interested seniors to participate and show their talent!

Also, on the registration form, list up to 3 service projects that your chapter has completed or plans to complete by the end of the year. In the spirit of fostering community service, we are producing a PowerPoint presentation in which we will feature your chapter's service project. If you would like to *provide digital photos of any of your projects so we may include them in the PowerPoint*, please email them to Srta del Valle by **January 30th**. Even if you are unable to attend the convention, please send us your community service activities so they may be shared with the rest of the state.

All chapters will need a <u>sign or poster with their school name and SHH chapter name</u>. Please plan to bring the sign/poster to the get-to-know you game and to the other meetings during the convention. Also, we ask <u>each male student coming to bring a 2-liter</u> bottle of soda and each female student to bring a snack to share (as determined by school after registration is complete).

¡Hola! Thank you for participating in this year's state SHH officer election. There are a few things you will need to know about your campaign and responsibilities as an officer.

CAMPAIGN NECESSITIES:

- 1. It is required that you send a photo of yourself (i.e. school picture) and a 1-2 paragraph biography in Spanish to the state sponsor. Email to Srta. Del Valle by **January 30th**.
- 2. You must prepare a 3-5 minute speech in Spanish to be given at the convention. This should not be a resume or a list of accomplishments, but should help the members get to know you or give an indication of your commitment and vision.
- 3. You may bring campaign posters, name tags, and any other promotional materials you wish to use. All materials should have your name and slogan on them. Posters may be put up in the meeting rooms of the lodge. You will be assigned a table area that you may decorate with campaign material. Please have a tri-fold for your table with information about yourself. Many schools like to hand out tokens, souvenirs for their candidate(s). Have fun and campaign actively. Circulate around the cafeteria and ask students from other schools to sign your "petition". This gives you the opportunity to meet and greet. Be creative!
- 4. The election policies, officer responsibilities, and the signature form stating you and your parents understand your commitments is included.
